

Hagg Wood


A walk of about 1½ miles (2 km) over fields and old trackways with a section of Ancient Woodland owned and managed by the Woodland Trust.

There are spectacular carpets of wood anemone in April and many different kinds of fungi in Autumn and Winter

The wood was managed to produce timber from oak trees and hazel sticks

for making baskets and fences

tall oak trees often with a single trunk
