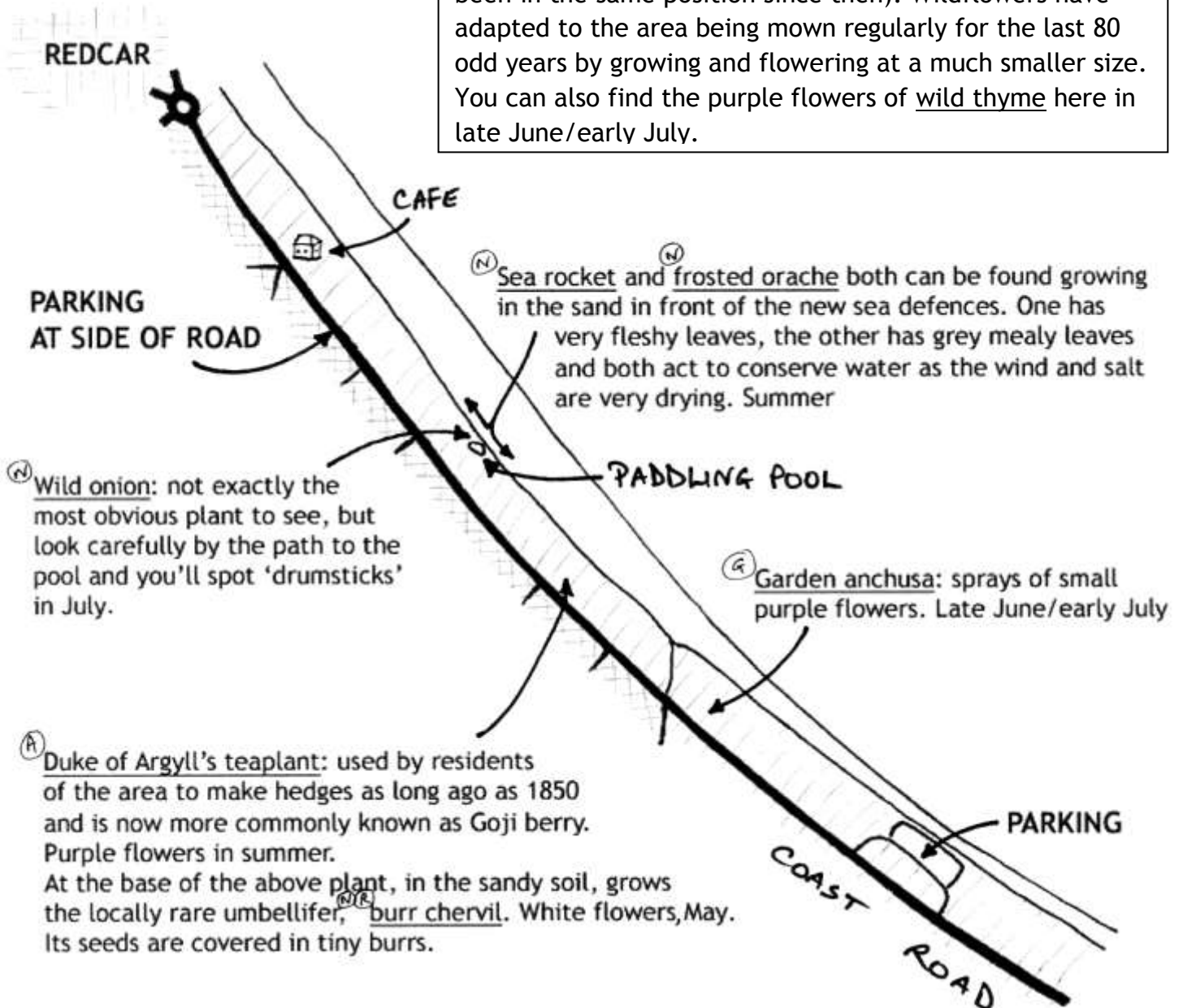


The Stray

The bumpy mown grass near the cafe used to be a putting green way back in the 1930's (the paddling pool has also been in the same position since then). Wildflowers have adapted to the area being mown regularly for the last 80 odd years by growing and flowering at a much smaller size. You can also find the purple flowers of wild thyme here in late June/early July.
