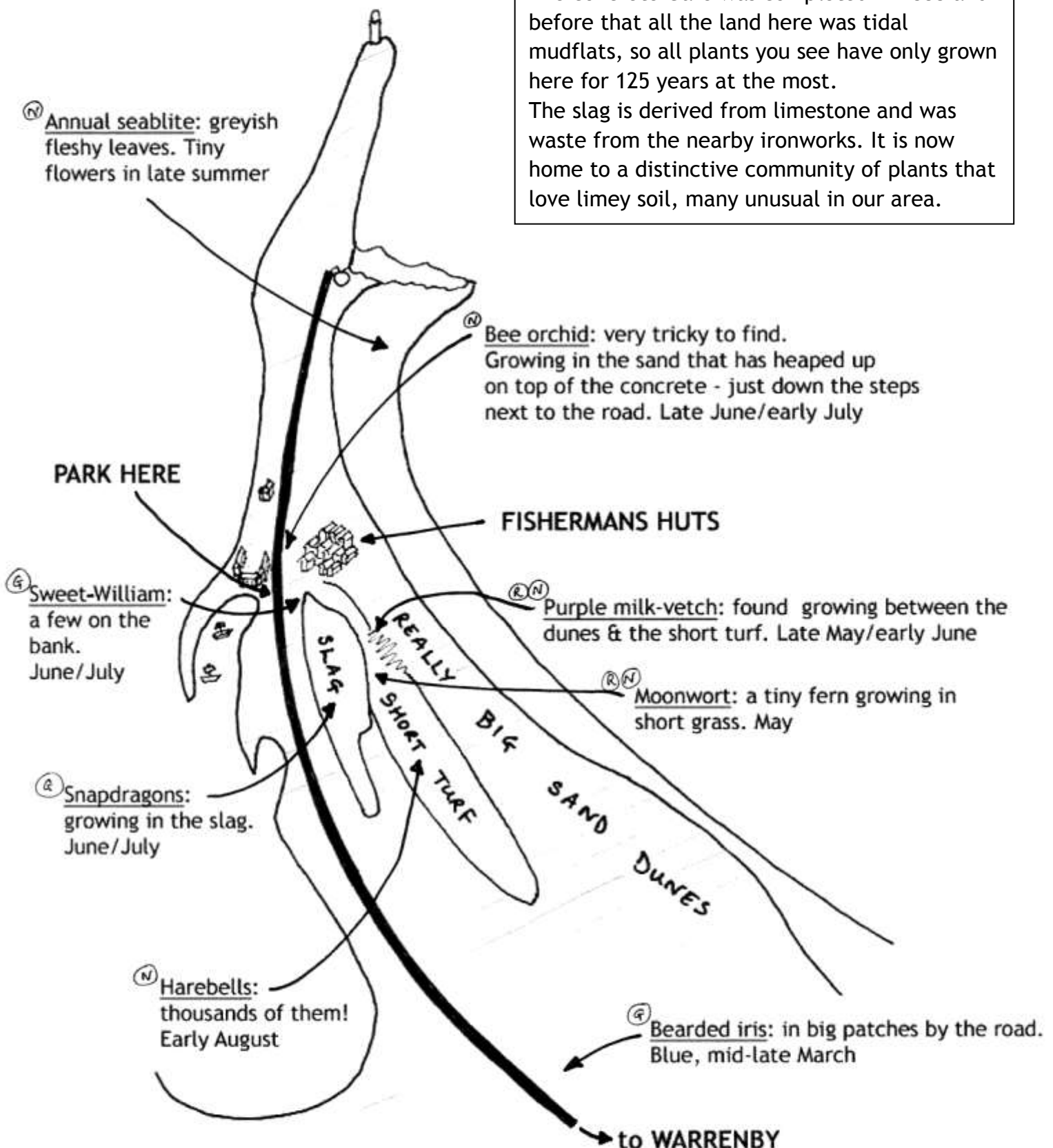


# South Gare

The concrete Gare was completed in 1888 and before that all the land here was tidal mudflats, so all plants you see have only grown here for 125 years at the most.

The slag is derived from limestone and was waste from the nearby ironworks. It is now home to a distinctive community of plants that love limey soil, many unusual in our area.
